coordinate plane- a coordinate grid that extends to include both positive and negative numbers.
coordinates- the two numbers in an ordered pair
horizontal- going side to side; parallel to the horizon
integers- the whole numbers and their opposites; 0 is its own opposite
intersect- to cross or meet
mean- the average of a set of numbers
median- the middle number in a set of data
mode- the number which appears most often in a set of numbers
origin- the point where the two axes of a coordinate plane intersect.
ordered pair- a pair of numbers used to locate a point on a coordinate grid parallel lines- two lines in a plane that do not cross each other pattern-repeating/recurring outcome perpendicular lines- two lines that intersect at a right angle range- the difference between the lowest and highest numbers in a data set $\underline{x}$-axis- $a$ horizontal line that includes both positive and negative numbers $y$-axis- a vertical line that includes both positive and negative numbers
